National Organization of Research Development Professionals Annual Business Meeting May 8, 2018

President Michael Spires called the annual business meeting of the National Organization of Research Development Professionals (NORDP) to order on May 8, 2018 during NORDP's annual conference held in Arlington, VA.

Approval of Draft May 10, 2017 Annual Meeting Minutes

Kelly Dyslin moved (seconded by Joanna Downer) to approve the minutes. The motion passed.

President's Remarks

- Record breaking year:
 - This 10th Annual NORDP Conference of 2018 broke registration records: 596 registrants from 278 institutions; 276 first time attendees (46.3%).
 - o NORDP's current membership is 923 members; 392 institutions
 - 513 of 923 NORDP members (55.58%) attended this year's meeting
 - This is 3x the national average for an organization conference attendance

Treasurer's Report

- Operating budget's fiscal year is from October 1 September 30.
 - Recurring expenses include our infrastructure through software subscriptions (e.g., webinar platform, teleconferencing, association management software and maintenance)
 - o Professional services (administrator/Association Management Company, attorney fees, graphic designer, insurance, accountant, etc.)
 - o Committee Programming

 - o Joanna Downer, PhD, from Duke School of Medicine, was awarded a NORD grant

Professional Development

 - o Six webinars were held since March 1, 2018, attended by 483 people
- New Initiatives
 - Developing Continuing Education Unit (CEU) program to facilitate use of NORDP activities to accrue CE for established certification (i.e., CRA)
