Summary: The Senior Director of Research at the UNC Gillings School of Global Public Health is a dynamic and collaborative member of Research and Innovation Solutions, one of the School's Central Administrative Units. In this role, they work directly with the Associate Dean for Research to advance the School's integrated research mission by engaging and collaborating extensively with faculty, staff, administrators and students in the School and across campus as well as with external partners to identify needs, establish a shared vision and purpose, set directions for the School, increase dollar value of research and numbers of researchers funded, manage compliance and stimulate responsive and innovative programs and activities to achieve strategic research priorities that meet the separate but intersecting needs of the School's stakeholders. The Senior Director of Research is the primary contact in the School for research activities, is responsible for day-to-day central strategic research operations, and is expected to maintain and build the prominence of the School's research program.

Educational Requirements:

A master's degree is required, PhD preferred.

Qualifications and Experience: 8-10 years of experience with research development, grants management or scientific writing and editing, and organizational responsibilities. Candidate must have some background in financial budgeting and account tracking. Experience in research compliance and/or conflict of interest management is required. Candidates must have demonstrated capacity to work in a highly collaborative research team and maintain positive and productive relationships within and outside the department, including faculty, staff, and project funders. A commitment to an inclusive climate at the Gillings School is required.
